YOU THINK THE JEWS ARE SMART? I THINK THEY'RE BRILLIANT!

(Buy low, sell high. Oldest rule in the book.)

- The US has been forced to buy Israeli goods, thanks to intricate manipulations by extremely clever Jews in the administration.

- Israel is allowed to export to the US, but any US exports to Israel are strictly limited. This costs US taxpayers about \$9 billion annually.

Folks, you know what I say about all this? Brilliant! Outstanding! Phenomenal! Only the creative Jews sequestered in a country that's hard to find on a map dares to give orders to a nation that covers half the map – and gets away with it.
