# Why Was a Holocaust Not Mentioned?

I've checked out Churchill's *Second World War* – not a single mention of Nazi “gas chambers,” a “genocide” of the Jews, or of “six million” Jewish victims of the war.

This is astonishing. How can it be explained?

- Eisenhower's *Crusade in Europe* is a book of 559 pages;
- the six volumes of Churchill's *Second World War* total 4,448 pages; and
- de Gaulle's three-volume *Mémoires de guerre* is 2,054 pages.

In this mass of writing, which altogether totals 7,061 pages (not including the introductory parts), published from 1948 to 1959, one will find **no mention** either of Nazi “gas chambers,” a “genocide” of the Jews, or of “six million” Jewish victims of the war.
